This is the first of what I hope will become a regular feature in Newsflash and on our Social Media pages. I would like to use this space as an opportunity to talk to our membership about issues that affect our Clubs and update you on upcoming events, exhibitions, workshops, Awards and Distinctions and celebrating recent members successes.



What's on the Agenda?
Communications: The WPF Executive pledged back in 2024 to increase its reach by engaging more with its membership. We took the time out last year to reflect, ask members and reassess what we do which led to our strategy as signed off at the 2025 AGM. More effective Communication was one of the key priorities our members asked for and this is our first step to making that happen.

Events: September saw our 2025 One Day Convention take place which was a huge success, turning a profit which will be put towards running our event next year - Congratulations and thanks go to Gareth Martin - roll on 2026. In October Monmouth Photographic Club successfully represented the WPF at the PAGB Inter-Club Print Championships and were placed 24th in the Plate Competition. Exhibitions: Work is underway for the Welsh Salon Exhibition in 2026 with more information available soon.

Workshops & Adjudications: November saw our AWPJ Adjudication event - another very successful event run by Dave Lewis for the final time as he hands over the reins to Roger Harrison. Thank you, Dave, for your diligence and determination to encourage and support so many people through their applications over the years. The new WPF Merit Awards Workshop was piloted in November - huge thanks to all our volunteers for their input to ensuring we have a viable proposition going forward. The Adjudication Day will be announced soon.


Distinctions & Awards: For the AWPJ Adjudication there were 22 entries with 17 candidates successfully achieving their AWPJ. Congratulations to all the successful applicants. We look forward to hearing and sharing some of your journeys to achieving this award over the coming months.


Upcoming & Save the Date: Work is already underway for the Memorials Trophy taking place on 21st February 2026 and I would like to thank Monmouth Photographic Club - Keith Sharples and his team, for volunteering to host and run this prestigious event once again in 2026. More details on applying will be available shortly.

Volunteering: We currently have nine volunteers on the Executive team, generously giving their time to help run the WPF and with the support of our Club Members we are able to provide a limited number of events - think what we could do with more involvement from more volunteers and Clubs! Story of an Image – Busy Day Sacre Coeur

Like many of you I have thousands of images stored on a number of external hard drives and yes, even on CD's ! Recently I have been looking through some of these and discovering that some captures which I have overlooked, but not sent to the recycle bin, that are worthy of further work. This often because over the 20 plus years since I started digital photography with Photoshop 5.5 massive improvements have been made and so many more useful plug-ins and alternative systems are available for us to use.

This image was taken 10 years ago when we spent a few days in Paris. I was using a Nikon V1 camera converted to Infra-red with exposure 1/800 sec, f5, ISO 200. Bringing it into my current version of Photoshop I was able to apply a few tweaks especially to darken the sky. I entered this into the Photo Travel section of a PSA recognised Salon in Bangladesh where it scored top points and was awarded a gold medal. The image was also accepted in the 2025 PSA International.

So, do you have gold lurking away in folders on your hard drives. I recommend having a look through and see what you can find you may be pleasantly surprised.

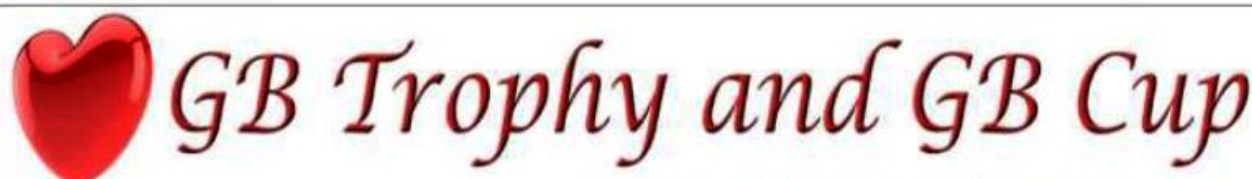

Note, **emails are not being hacked**. They just pretend to be someone else by covering the actual sending email address. Recent emails came from mailing79joo@gmail.com but a familiar name was used to disguise that bit.

Report all such emails by forwarding them to: report@phishing.gov.uk

Be vigilant. Don't open any suspicious attachments or follow unusual links.
