Sections – There are four: Open Colour Prints, Open Mono Prints, Open PDIs and Phone PDIs (new). Four images may be entered into each section.

Entry Fee – The minimum entry fee is £8 for up to four images. Further images are £2 each, up to a maximum of four in each section. The maximum entry charge is £32.

Closing date: 8th March 2026. Deadlines – PDIs midnight on Sunday 8th March 2026. Prints midday on Sunday 8th March at Talbot Green before the WPF AGM.

Selectors: Gordon Jenkins, Gary Shinner and Susan Ashford.

Exhibition: The exhibition will be formally opened at midday on Saturday 2nd May at the Cynon Valley Museum, Aberdare. CF44 8DL.

Photographers collect points from acceptances, mentions and awards in international exhibitions (CROWN and VIP distinctions) or by submitting their own portfolio and gaining titles (Aphrodite, Hermes, Zeus and the recently added highest title of Grand Master).

We (Rob and I) joined GPU just over three years ago and have been impressed by the friendly and supporting Group – it feels like a world-wide camera club. We joined the Photo Festival last year in Krakow it was such good value for money and a great way to meet everyone.

The portfolio is **FREE** to hire but Clubs are required to pay the postage to its next location and perhaps from its current location unless this is another Club.



Note, **emails are not being hacked**. They just pretend to be someone else by covering the actual sending email address. Recent emails came from mailing79joo@gmail.com but a familiar name was used to disguise that bit.

Report all such emails by forwarding them to: report@phishing.gov.uk

Be vigilant. Don’t open any suspicious attachments or follow unusual links.
